Nominations for election to the May, 2018, 39th General Convention of the International Union of Operating Engineers, will be held at the January 2018 District Meetings.

Pursuant to Article III, Section 3 of the International Constitution, "The election of delegates shall be conducted by secret ballot. In order to be eligible to be a candidate for delegate, a member must, at the time of nomination, be in good standing with respect to payment of dues and meet the requirements contained in the second paragraph of Article XXIV, Subdivision 1, Section (b). In addition, Local Unions may impose in their bylaws a requirement that candidates for delegate must file a nominating petition in support of their candidacies signed by not more than two-hundred (200) members or two percent (2%) of the entire membership, whichever is less."

In accordance with the Bylaws of the International Union of Operating Engineers Local 501, nominations for delegates shall be held at a notified meeting in January preceding the election. In addition to meeting

the other requirements provided in the International Constitution, candidates for delegates must file a nominating petition at any District meeting in January. A copy of the petition will be supplied by the Recording-Corresponding Secretary upon written request at 2405 W 3rd Street Los Angeles, CA 90057 or 501coms@local501.org

In addition to the Principal Officers the Local will be electing (13) delegates and (3) alternates for the convention.

The election of delegates will be held in the month of February. All members in good standing of Local 501 and its Subdivisions are eligible to vote and be elected, except members of Registered Apprentice Subdivision, who, according to International Constitution, are eligible to vote but are not eligible to be nominated or elected.
